The members with a balance on their membership fee must pay monthly payments. If you have any questions, call Mrs. Freeman 778-7199 or leave a message on voice mail at the club 642-8646. When you pay your annual dues, return the statement indicating any changes of your membership such as address change or number of persons living in your household. Children 14 years of age or older will receive a membership card instead of using a patch. Remember that your children are eligible for a membership card as long as they live in your household (including students enrolled in college).

If you will be unable to use the Dolphin Club facility, but wish to remain active, you may pay the inactive dues of \$50.00. Members who have not paid inactive or regular dues for two years will be removed from the membership books. To reactive your file, there is a \$75.00 reinstatement fee plus payment of inactive dues for the appropriate years.

SWIM TEAM NEWS

The Swim Team completed the 2010 season with nearly 60 swimmers. The Dolphin club hosted its 41st Invitational with the slogan "Proud to be Outdoors since 1969". The Dolphins hosted its largest Invitational since 2000, with 16 teams, 14 from Indiana, and 2 swimmers representing teams from Michigan and Florida. Altogether nearly 340 swimmers competed, up from last year's total of 220. Boilermaker Aquatics finished first, followed by our own ACAC Dolphins. Pendleton finished 3rd, Cardinal Community Swim club from Muncie was 4th, followed by Greenfield, New Castle, Giant Aquatics from Indy, Maverick Aquatics from Lafayette, Sugar Creek Swim Club from Crawfordsville, Goshen, Oak Hill (Marion), Lebanon, Yorktown, and Delaware County.

Our Dolphins were led in scoring by Kyle Johnson, 16, who was the high point winner in the senior division with 77 points; Kyle won all seven of his events. Hamilton Smith, 13, was second in scoring for the Dolphins with 57 points, with one win, five seconds, and a 4th. Abby Boerner, 8, was third with 52 points, with four first and a second. Colin Hoffman, 19, was fourth with 42 points, he finaled in seven events and won two. Hannah Boerner, 11, was fifth in scoring with 40 points, Jake Fugate, 16, was sixth with 36 points. Allie Bramwell, 7, was seventh with 33 points, Keagan Johnson, 8, was eighth and 32 points, Mason Stoner, 8, was ninth with 30, and Brooke Sigler, 16, rounded out the top ten with 25 points.

Hamilton Smith was the only Dolphin to advance to the Age Group State Meet for 14 and unders in Indianapolis July 23rd - 25th. Kyle Johnson, Colin Hoffman, Jake Fugate, and Jason Cramer qualified for Senior State at IU Bloomington July 29th - August 1st. The ACAC Dolphins were the 19th best men's team at the Senior State Meet with 83 points, Colin Hoffman set two new Dolphins Club records, finished 3rd at State in the 100 breaststroke 1:06.42, and 9th at State in the 200 breaststroke 2:34.29. Kyle Johnson was the 2nd fastest 100 backstroke at State among 16 and under, and 3rd fastest 100 butterfly at Ste among 16 and unders. All three of our relays cored points at State, led by our 13th place in the 400 Medley Relay, 16th in the 800 Freestyle Relay, and 17th in the 400 Freestyle Relay. Dolphin Club members: Kyle Johnson and Jake Fugate competed on all three of the relays while Colin Hoffman swam on both and 400 Medley and 400 Free Relays, and Jason Cramer swam on the 800 Free Relay.

At the swim team awards banquet Tyler Poole earned the Dedicated Dolphin Award and Kyle Johnson and

Hamilton Smith were co-winners of the Scott Craig Mental Attitude Award.
